The Metro PAC board guides the committee's strategic objectives, helps raise funds for the Metro PAC and three independent expenditure committees, conducts candidate interviews before each election cycle and authorizes campaign contributions to support local and state legislative candidates throughout the six county region of El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties.

The Metro EDGE PAC Chair serves a one year term on behalf of Metro EDGE and must know the mission, values and core beliefs of EDGE and represent these values when making decisions on its behalf on the Metro PAC. The Metro EDGE PAC Chair will serve on the Leadership Council in an ex-officio position and be a member of the Regional Action Committee, but not lead or co-lead a committee during their tenure.
