SPECIFIC EXPECTATIONS & GUIDELINES

- **As Chair, you are required to commit four years to serve on the Leadership Council. You will serve the first year as 2nd Vice Chair, the second year as Vice Chair, the third year as**

Chair and the fourth year as a member of the Sponsorships Committee.

- **You must be a current member of Metro EDGE during your entire tenure as a member of the Leadership Council.**
- **Your attendance at annual Leadership Council planning retreats is mandatory. The 2017 planning retreat will be November 4-5, 2016 (Sutter Creek, CA).**
 - An opportunity to create the program's annual accomplishment wish list, all incoming Leadership Council members are required to attend this strategy session to determine specific goals for 2017.
 - In addition to planning for the 2017 year, workshops offering critical leadership skills and business planning will be offered at no charge to members of the incoming Leadership Council.
- **You must attend a minimum 11 of 12 monthly Leadership Council meetings.**
 - Meetings are 3:30-5:30p every first Wednesday of the month at a downtown Sacramento location.
 - Purpose of the monthly meetings is to recap current Metro EDGE news and recent events, discuss and plan new events, delegate action items and responsibilities, discuss committee specific ideas and general program ideas.
- **You must attend a minimum of 10 Metro EDGE events per year.**
 - Each committee will require a focus on their specific events.
 - Although we all may have specific focuses within the program, it is crucial for each member of the Leadership Council to experience a taste of all EDGE has to offer.
- **You must attend a minimum of 5 community events as a representative of Metro EDGE.**
 - Community events may include the State of the City, City Council meetings, etc.
- **You must recruit at least 10 new EDGE members.**
 - Member growth and expansion is key to the program's success and it is the responsibility of all engaged members to shoulder this task themselves.

As Second Vice Chair in 2017, you must also:

- **Attend a minimum of 1 monthly committee meeting for Metro EDGE committees as Vice Chair.**

As Vice Chair in 2018, you must also:

- **Attend the annual Metro Chamber Business Awards and Dinner in early 2018.**
- **Attend Cap-to-Cap 2018 as a representative of Metro EDGE.**

- The cost of your reservation will be sponsored by Metro EDGE
- **Attend the 2018 Metro Chamber Study Mission as a representative of Metro EDGE.**
 - The cost of your reservation will be sponsored by Metro EDGE
- **Attend the annual Metro Chamber board retreat in November 2018.**

As Chair in 2019, you must also:

- **Attend the annual Metro Chamber Business Awards and Dinner in early 2019.**
- **Attend Cap-to-Cap 2019 as a representative of Metro EDGE.**
 - The cost of your reservation will be sponsored by Metro EDGE
- **Attend the 2019 Metro Chamber Study Mission as a representative of Metro EDGE.**
 - The cost of your reservation will be sponsored by Metro EDGE

In 2020, you must also:

- Participate as a member of the Sponsorships committee
